How to get to the hotel?

If you come from..

London Heathrow: Take the Piccadilly line to Russell Square station

Gatwick Airport: Take the Thameslink service to St Pancras International and walk (10 minutes) or change to the Piccadilly line (1 stop) to Russell Square

Stansted Airport: Take the train to Tottenham Hale then change to the Victoria line to Kings Cross. From Kings Cross it's a 10 minutes walk or one more stop on the Piccadilly line to Russell Square

London City Airport: Take the DLR to Bank then change to the Central line to Holborn. You can walk from there (12 minutes) or take the Piccadilly line (1 stop) to Russell Square
