EpiCARE is developing **patient-centred interactive e-learning modules** in collaboration with the ILAE. These modules are focusing on **diagnosis and management of some rare and complex epilepsies** and will integrate the currently ongoing ILAE learning program development, corresponding to different levels of professional expertise in epileptology (here: proficiency level (2) according to the [ILAE curriculum](#)).

Each e-learning module presents a patient case in a highly interactive and self-paced manner, including exercises and quizzes with feedback.
