Calls for collaborative genetic research



One of the missions of the ERN EpiCARE is to promote clinical research and the production of cross-border collaborative work on genetic epilepsies.

On our website, we share the opportunities of collaborative calls for European series of patients carrying variants in already known genes but with limited knowledge that need to be expanded.

EpiCARE can facilitate this type of studies by connecting several centers across Europe involved in the study of genetic epilepsies.

We currently have calls for the following genes: GRIA, KCNQ2 and EEF1A2, RORA, GABAAR, VARIA-ATP1A3, SPATA5, DLG64, YWHAG, FZR1, KCNB1, KCNT1, SLC12A5, DNM1L, SCN2A.


