Guidelines International Network



The EpiCARE Guidelines group is currently working on 7 task forces (Lennox Gastaut Syndrome, Infantile Epileptic Spasms, Dravet Syndrome, Status Epilepticus, Epilepsy Surgery (Presurgical Evaluation, Epilepsy Surgery and Neuromodulation) and have already finalized three protocols.

They have established working groups and have strengthened the collaboration between four involved societies (EAN,ILAE,EPNS and EpiCARE) so far.

They also strengthened the guideline network collaboration to other societies around the world and had the chance to meet and learn from experts for guideline development.

DEE clinical case discussion (Italian) - November 17th


