

Jardin project meeting in Brussels



On 8 March, the JARDIN (Joint Action on integration of ERNs into national healthcare systems) project meeting was held in Brussels. The conference showcased a strong, united commitment from EU institutions, Member States, EURORDIS, and the broader patient advocate community towards integrating ERNs into national healthcare systems and advancing EU rare disease policies. Many stakeholders were present, interesting discussions were held on a challenging project designed to serve patients with rare diseases. Thanks to HADEA for organising and hosting the meeting, Till Voigtlaender for coordinating JARDIN, DG SANTE, ERN coordinators, patient representatives, representatives of the Board of Member States and all others for their commitment.



"Managing Epilepsies in Crisis Situations - The Ukraine Experience"

On 21 March, ERN EpiCARE had the honour to welcome two eminent colleagues, also members of the Ukrainian chapter of the International **League Against Epilepsy**, Professors **Andriy Dubenko** and **Volodymyr Kharytonov**. They shared with us their experience during these 2 years of war, in an educational webinar on "Managing Epilepsies in Crisis Situations - The Ukraine Experience".

The webinar was moderated by Professors **Maša Malenica** and **Alexis Arzimanoglou**. They both renewed the full support of EpiCARE to patients and colleagues from Ukraine, in sharing expertise and for orienting patients, particularly war refugees with rare epilepsies, towards reference centres in Europe.

Treatment Strategies in Pediatric Epilepsies (EPIPED) - Girona, Spain. Dates: 10 – 13 april




EPIPED is a 3 years cycle of independent annual training courses (2017-2019), developed specifically for child neurologists and physicians treating children with epilepsy, particularly rare and complex epilepsies. Victoria San Antonio, Jaume Campistol, Alexis Arzimanoglou are the Course Directors.

Topics treated are related to pharmacology, pharmacodynamics, pharmacokinetics, analysis of AED trials, design of clinical trials, pre-surgical evaluation, optimal choice of AEDs, review of existing guidelines (ILAE, NICE, other), ketogenic diet, neurostimulation, indications for resective and palliative surgery, pharmacological treatments other than AEDs, development of educational therapy programs.

The registration is now **close** because the course is full, but there is **more information here**.

State of the art anatomo-clinical correlations of focal seizures. 17th Paros Epilepsy Surgery Workshop and U-Tas Meeting - Paros, Greece. Dates: 22–26 april.



Epilepsy surgery has been relying on anatomo-clinical correlation for more than a century and much knowledge has been accumulated over decades, in particular since the advances of long-term video-EEG monitoring.

The comprehensive systematic assessment of these anatomo-clinical correlations is much needed, and have thus organized these sessions with the joint endorsement support of the European Reference Network EpiCARE, ILAE-Europe and the ILAE educational journal Epileptic Disorders. Alexis Arzimanoglou, Sandor Beniczky, Philippe Kahane, Vasilis Kimiskidis and Philippe Ryvlin are the organizing committee of this event.
