Reminder : designation of an ERN EpiCARE project

One of the EpiCARE Research Council's role is to support the applications to research calls by its designation as an EpiCARE Project. An EpiCARE project is defined as a project that is led by at least **one HCP member of EpiCARE** and **involving two or more members**. The conditions of this designation are:

- Must be brought to the research council prior to application
- Has undergone quality check/peer review
- Has received approval by the Research Council

ERN EpiCARE project support: Please note that there is the possibility for EpiCARE to support a project without necessarily offer a designation of an application as an EpiCARE project.

1. European partnership fostering a European Research Area (ERA) for health research *HORIZON-HLTH-2022-DISEASE-03-01*

Deadline model: single-stage

Planned opening date: 12 January 2022

Deadline date: 21 April 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time

Budget: 30 M€

2. Development of new effective therapies for rare diseases *HORIZON-HLTH-2022-DISEASE-06-04-two-stage*

Deadline model: two-stage

Planned opening date: 06 October 2021

Deadline dates: 01 February 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time ; 06 September 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time

Budget: 60 M€ - 8M€ per project

3. Optimising effectiveness in patients of existing prescription drugs for major diseases (except cancer) with the use of biomarkers

Indicative budget: 60 million (6 projects at 10 million per project)

5. Computational models for new patient stratification strategies

6. Pre-commercial research and innovation procurement (PCP) for building the resilience of health care systems in the context of recovery

Deadline model: single-stage

Budget: 25 M€ - 5 M€ per project

7. Public procurement of innovative solutions (PPI) for building the resilience of health care systems in the context of recovery

Type of action: HORIZON-PPI HORIZON Public Procurement of Innovative Solutions
Deadline model: single-stage
Planned opening date: 06 October 2021
Deadline date: 21 April 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time
Budget: 15 M€ - 5 M€ per project

8. ERC Synergy Grants - ERC-2022-SyG

Deadline model: single-stage
Opening date: 15 July 2021
Deadline date: 10 November 2021 17:00:00 Brussels time
Budget: € 10 million for a period of 6 years (pro rata for projects of shorter duration). However an addition € 4 million can be requested in the proposal in total.

9. ERC STARTING GRANTS - ERC-2022-STG

Deadline model: single-stage
Planned opening date: 23 September 2021
Deadline date: 13 January 2022 17:00:00 Brussels time
Budget: up to € 1.5 million for a period of 5 years. (pro rata for projects of shorter duration). However, an additional € 1 million can be made available to cover eligible “start-up” costs for researchers moving from a third country to the EU or an associated country and/or the purchase of major equipment and/or access to large facilities and/or other major experimental and field work costs.

10. Neurobiology Commission Bursaries

Announcing a funding opportunity for young trainees and investigators with limited financial resources to attend scientific meetings, workshops, or other training opportunities that promise to advance their research career. The bursaries will cover travel expenses to a **maximum of \$2,000** per applicant to attend a scientific or training activity.

Deadline: 31 October 2021.

11. Workshop Funding

Funding for scientific meetings or workshops relevant to neurobiology of epilepsy can also be provided through the NBC. Requests for sponsoring such workshops are considered for funding on an annual basis by the NBC.

To apply, please complete the NBC Funding Request Form by 31 July of the year preceding the planned meeting. Decisions on support will be announced by the end of March of the year of the event.

12. MSCA Doctoral Networks 2021 *HORIZON-MSCA-2021-DN-01*

Deadline model: single-stage

Opening date: 22 June 2021

Deadline date: 16 November 2021 17:00:00 Brussels time

Budget: 402,95 M€

13. Sinergia – interdisciplinary, collaborative and breakthrough

Sinergia promotes the interdisciplinary collaboration of two to four research groups that propose breakthrough research.

Submission deadline: 01.12.2021

Grants Duration: 1 to 4 years

A maximum amount of **CHF 3.2 million (2.9 M€)** may be requested in a Sinergia application.

The minimum amount that may be requested is **CHF 50,000 (46 089 M€)**.
